Paragraph Worksheet for **Writing & Speaking**

Paragraphs are groups of sentences that have a single idea. A paragraph typically includes:

Structure of a paragraph

For example:

- Topic Sentence	→ Horses are farm animals.
- Supporting Sentences	→ They are usually black, grey, white or brown in colour.
	→ They like eating grass. They have long legs, which
	→ are very strong. They can easily run long distances.
	→ Horses have hard hooves which protect their feet.
	→ They carry people and goods from one place to another.
- Concluding Sentence	→ They are very useful animals.

- **Topic Sentence:** Write a sentence that states the main idea or topic of a paragraph.
- **Supporting Sentence:** Write facts or descriptions that relate to the topic.
- **Concluding Sentence:** Re-word the introduction to sum up the ideas in the paragraph to bring it to a close.

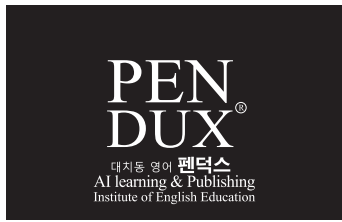
