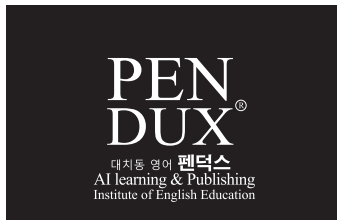

Structure of a paragraph

For example:

- Topic Sentence
- Supporting Sentences
- Concluding Sentence

→ Doctors are great people.

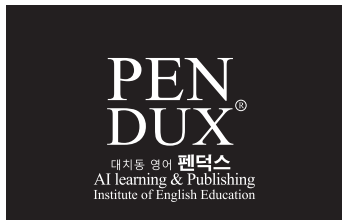
