Paragraph Worksheet for **Writing & Speaking**

Paragraphs are groups of sentences that have a single idea. A paragraph typically includes:

Structure of a paragraph

For example:

- Topic Sentence	→ Doctors are great people.
- Supporting Sentences	→ Doctors are people who look after sick people and prescribe medicine so that the patients recover fast.
	→ Doctors' lives are very busy. They get up early in the morning and go to the hospital. They often work without taking a break. They study for a long time to save our lives.
- Concluding Sentence	→ Since doctors work so hard, we must realize their value.

- **Topic Sentence:** Write a sentence that states the main idea or topic of a paragraph.
- **Supporting Sentence:** Write facts or descriptions that relate to the topic.
- **Concluding Sentence:** Re-word the introduction to sum up the ideas in the paragraph to bring it to a close.

- **Supporting Sentences:** I was awake because I was watching a soccer match. It started at 1 a.m. and ended at 3 a.m. I was very excited because I could watch my favorite player, Lionel Messi. I watched the match on my computer. Messi scored two goals, so I was happy when the match ended. At 3 a.m., my house is so quiet that you can hear the refrigerator.
- **Concluding Sentence:** So, the reason I was awake by myself was to watch a fun soccer match.

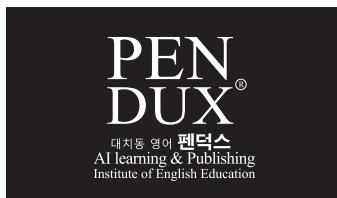
