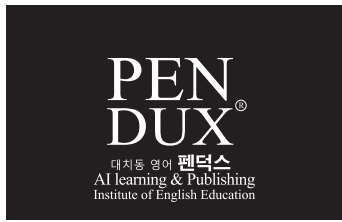

Paragraph Worksheet for Writing & Speaking

Paragraphs are groups of sentences that have a single idea. A paragraph typically includes:

Structure of a paragraph

For example:

- Topic Sentence
- Supporting Sentences
- Concluding Sentence

→ Doctors are great people.
 → Doctors are people who look after sick people and prescribe medicine so that the patients recover fast.
 → Doctors' lives are very busy. They get up early in the morning and go to the hospital. They often work without taking a break. They study for a long time to save our lives.
 → Since doctors work so hard, we must realize their value.

- Topic Sentence: Write a sentence that states the main idea or topic of a paragraph.
- Supporting Sentence: Write facts or descriptions that relate to the topic.
- Concluding Sentence: Re-word the introduction to sum up the ideas in the paragraph to bring it to a close.

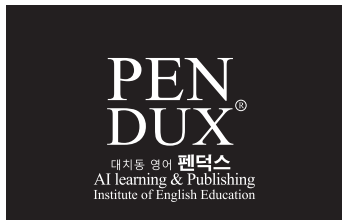
TOPIC: Imagine if you were left to look after your baby brother and he accidentally locked you in a closet.

Sample:

- Topic Sentence: If I were left to look after my baby brother and he accidentally locked me in a closet, I would start to panic.
- Supporting Sentences: The first thing to do would be to call my parents. However, if I did not have my cell phone, I think I would keep knocking on the door and shouting at him. I would call his name over and over to tell him where I am. Meanwhile, I think my baby brother would mess up the whole house because nobody is looking after him. Also, he would begin to wonder where I am. If he started to cry for any reason, I would panic even more because I would not know whether he is hurt or scared. I would not be afraid to break the door, if it needed to be. However, I hope my parents would come before I break the door.
- Concluding Sentence: Although I would be nervous in the beginning, I would try to get out by any means needed.

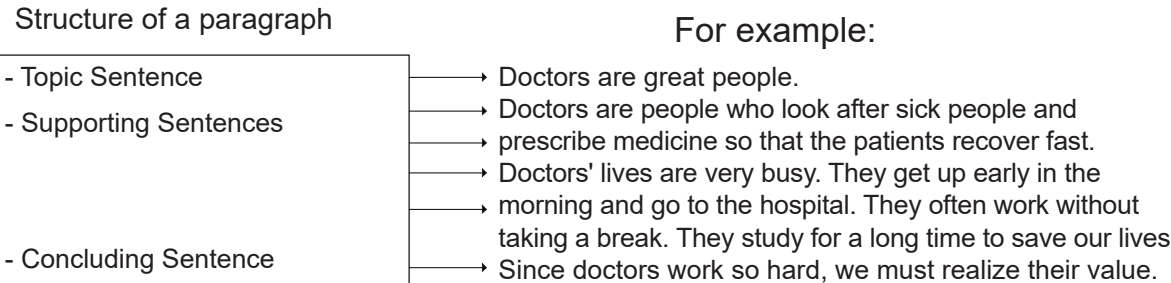
