But in the last 10 years, there have been many such tragic scenes of violence involving guns in colleges and even schools across the United States.

It sounds weird but buying a hand gun in the US is like buying milk or chewing gum. Any adult who has not been convicted for a crime can buy a handgun. A person who buys a handgun does not need to know how his gun works or how to handle it safely. Most families keep their guns loaded or unlocked or both. It leads to tragic accidents.

In the United States there are strict laws about safety standards for practically everything you can think of. Toys cannot be made of any toxic material. Manufacturers of food stuff must not use ingredients harmful to health. Every tool has detailed instructions about safety features. Manufacturers who ignore them can be hauled up by law. But there are no safety standards for gun manufacturers! The US Consumer Product Safety Commission has no powers to see that gun manufacturers ensure safety standards in the design, manufacture and marketing of firearms.

On Mother's Day, May 14, 2000, about 750,000 mothers and other sympathetic people gathered in the US capital Washington DC to demand stricter gun laws. About 150,000 people marched in other American cities in their support. Since then the Million Mom March movement has spread across the US. They demand laws that keep children and adults safe at home, in school, in the workplace and in the community.

But all hope is not lost. More and more ordinary Americans are saying they do not want gun violence to be an answer to every problem on the street or even at home. When mothers decide to act, it is time for wrong doers to take notice.
