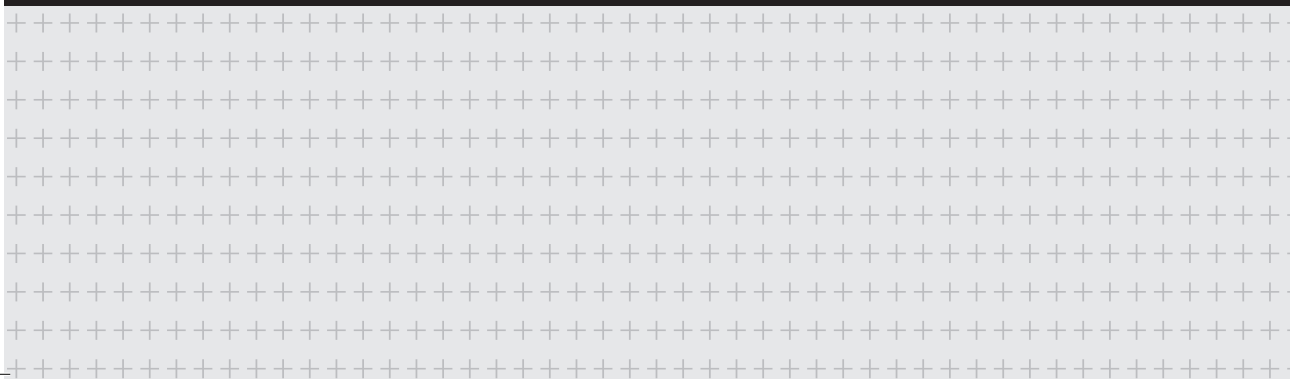

UNIT 01

Everywhere we look, there are signs. We can find them on posts. We can find them on buildings. Where else can we find them? Signs are also found on windows and doors.

We see street signs all the time. Each sign carries important information. It often tells us what to do. The traffic sign tells us when to walk and stop. **A construction sign guides us on where to go and where not to go.** A road sign informs us how fast we can go or how far a place is.

Signs often give us warnings. For example, they warn us about children playing or animals on the road. That sign is also for the safety of the children or the animal **itself**. It also tells us to drive under the speed limit on a **particularly** dangerous stretch of road.

How do signs warn or guide us? People make signs for lots of things. They make signs for sales, to find lost animals, and even to represent the position of planets. People also use signs for advertisements.

What other things do people make signs for? Can you find any signs near you right now? What does ★it tell you to do?
