[The two men are helping the woman carry her bags.]

eager (adj)

wanting very much.
[He is very eager in his studies.]

able (adj)

having the power or knowledge to do something.
[I've never been able to paint.]

devour (v)

to eat or swallow in a greedy way.

dig (v)

to make a hole by removing dirt, sand, or other material.

[The worker uses a machine to dig the hole.]

whisper (v)

to speak softly and quietly.

[He whispered in his voice.]

believe (v)

to accept as honest or true.

pretend (v)

to give an appearance of something being true or real when it is not true or real.

[I don't like people who pretend to be a man of altruism.]

lay (v)

to put something down so that it is flat against a surface.

[I love to lay a place for my parents on Sunday mornings.]

desperate (adj)

having almost no way to escape from or solve.

[He was in a desperate situation.]

strange (adj)

not usual; odd.

[A strange noise broke his sleep.]

heat (v)

to cause to become warm or hot.

[I'll heat up some coffee for you.]

whole (adj)

an entire or complete thing.

[We worked the whole night through.]

grow (v)

to become larger; increase.

[I've decided to become a minister when I grow up.]
