**soil (v)**

to make something filthy or dirty  
[Don't soil your clothes when you play outside!]

**soon (adv)**

not long after the present time; quickly  
[I hope to see you soon!]

**brain (n)**

the control center of thought and body activity  
of all creatures  
[I can trust my brain.]

**poor (adj)**

people with little or no money  
[There was the big gap between rich and poor people in  
this country.]

**play (v)**

not to work; to take part in a sport; to make  
music on an instrument  
[The band played all night long.]

**please (v)**

to make someone happy; to give enjoyment  
[These colors please the senses.]

<b>bottle (n)</b>	a container, usually made of glass, to hold liquid [Bring a bottle of wine!]
<b>boil (v)</b>	to heat a liquid until it becomes very hot [Can you boil water without heat?]
<b>chief (n)</b>	the head or leader of a group [Humor is my chief teaching tool in the class.]
<b>bomb (n)</b>	a device that explodes with great force [We have a bomb on board.]
<b>bone (n)</b>	the hard material in the body [The dog hid the bone behind the tree.]
<b>cold (adj)</b>	feeling great coolness or a low temperature [It was cold, and snowing outside, but I had the fan on because I get hot easily.]
<b>acid (n)</b>	having a sour taste [A substance that forms a salt when it reacts with acid.]
<b>automatic (adj)</b>	independent of external control [It also has an automatic document feeder that scans up to 25 pages per minute.]
<b>awake (adj)</b>	not in a state of sleep

**clock (n)**

a device that measures and shows time  
[The clock is ticking.]

**bent (adj)**

not straight , curved  
[The stick was bent.]

**cloth (n)**

a material made of cotton or wool that you  
use for making clothes

**cloud (n)**

a mass of very small drops of water that  
floats in the sky and is usually white or grey

**dance (v)**

to move the body and feet to music

**danger (n)**

a strong chance of suffering injury or damage  
[Mountain climbing is always attended with danger.]

**discuss (v)**

consider, argue, debate dispute  
[We discussed what we should do after graduation.]
