(Pronouns) This/That

- 'This' is a demonstrative pronoun which refers to something that is nearest to the speaker.
- 'That' is a demonstrative pronoun which refers to something that is separated from the speaker by space or time.

Example

This is my friend.
 Is **that** your friend?
 Let's have lunch together!
This sandwich is delicious.
That smells very good. I like **that**.
