01 (Negative) I am not (I'm not)

- 'not' is used to form a negative phrase after verbs like 'be.'
- We use 'I am not(I'm not)' for 'I'.

Example

I am Wendy. **I am not** Cindy.
 I am a florist. **I'm not** a teacher.
I'm not Korean. I'm Italian.
I am not in the room. I am at the shop.
I'm not sad. I'm happy.
