(Regular Verbs) Play/Listen/Walk/Talk/Open

- For regular verbs, we add -ed to the base form of the verb or -d if the verb already ends in e.

Example

What did you do last weekend?

I listened to the music all day long.

He cooked for his parents.

She walked with her dog.

We enjoyed our free time.
