#### (Present perfect) I/You have + asked/cooked/helped

• We use the present perfect simple to refer to events in the past but which connect to the present. We use 'have + past participle form of the verb.'

# **E**xample

I have lived in Seoul since 1990.

You have lived in Tokyo since 2001.

You have stayed in Beijing since last night.

I have stayed in Beijing since last week.

I have enjoyed the trip a lot.
