## (Prepositions) at (time)

· We use at to talk about points in time, ages and some periods of time.

# **Example**

I met my friends at 11 o'clock.

Karina came to join us at noon.

We had lunch at 1pm.

We went to the restaurant at 6pm.

We watched a horror film at midnight.
