- 2. Supporting Sentence 1 Ali is twelve years old. She lives next door to me.
- 3. Supporting Sentence 2
  4. Supporting Sentence 3
  We always have fun together everyday.
  Best of all, she's on my soccer team.
- 5. Concluding Sentence I think she is the greatest friend I've ever had.
- Topic Sentence: Write a sentence that states the main idea or topic of a paragraph.
- Supporting Sentence: Write facts or descriptions that relate to the topic.
- Concluding Sentence: Re-word the introduction to sum up the ideas in the paragraph to bring it to a close.
