Structure of a paragraph

For example:

- 1. Topic Sentence
- 2. Supporting Sentence 1
- 3. Supporting Sentence 2
- 4. Supporting Sentence 3
- 5. Concluding Sentence

Concluding Sentences: These are the reasons I like this pair of shoes.

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
