Paragraphs are groups of sentences that have a single idea. A paragraph typically includes:

Structure of a paragraph

For example:

1. Topic Sentence	Let me tell you about my best friend.
2. Supporting Sentence 1	Ali is twelve years old. She lives next door to me.
3. Supporting Sentence 2	──── We always have fun together everyday.
4. Supporting Sentence 3	──── Best of all, she's on my soccer team.
5. Concluding Sentence	I think she is the greatest friend I've ever had.

• Topic Sentence: Write a sentence that states the main idea or topic of a paragraph.

Supporting Sentence: Write facts or descriptions that relate to the topic.

• Concluding Sentence: Re-word the introduction to sum up the ideas in the paragraph to

bring it to a close.

- When was it? Where did you learn it?

- Explain what you learned.

- Why did you find it interesting?

- Where did you use it?


